All In All Out

1. **Purpose:** To prevent transmission of disease from flock to flock
2. **Responsibility:** Farm Staff
3. **Frequency:** For each flock
4. **Biosecurity Protocols**
 - 4.1 Practice All-In placement of poultry flocks

- 4.2 When housing poultry, flocks should be of one type of poultry and of one age group.
Hatchery Supply Records will provide this information.
- 4.3 All pens should be housed at the same time and from the same source
- 4.4 Keep Flock performance Records for each pen

- 4.5 All barns should be housed at one time from the same source
- 4.6 All poultry cages or pens and barns on a farm site should be housed at one time
- 4.7 All poultry on the farm can be treated as one flock
- 4.8 Farm staff only need to change clothing at farm site TA
- 4.9 Practice All-Out poultry shipping
- 4.10 All birds in a flock should be shipped at the same time period
- 4.11 All poultry cages, pens and barns on a farmsite are empty at one time
- 4.12 Farm site can be cleaned and disinfected properly to break the pathogen cycle when all birds are gone

5. Biosecurity Deviation Protocol

- 5.1 If the multi-barn farm site barns contain different aged birds or different types of poultry, the barns are to be kept isolated from one another
- 5.2 These barns are to be treated as different flocks with strict biosecurity procedures followed when tending flocks like going from youngest to oldest and staff putting on separate biosecurity clothing in each barns TA
- 5.3 When shipping, all the birds in the barn must be shipped at once. Shipping slips can be used to determine if all birds were shipped at one time
